NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Fire District No. 3, in the Township of Lower, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. This RESOLUTION shall be known and may be cited as the Cooperative Pricing Resolution of Fire District No. 3, Lower Township, Cape May County, New Jersey.
- 2. Pursuant to the provisions of *N.J.S.A.* 40A:11-11(5), the Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer are hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Pricing System Agreement with the Lead Agency that is attached hereto as <u>EXHIBIT "A"</u>, which is hereby approved.
- 3. The Lead Agency shall be responsible for complying with the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey.
 - 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
